**BIG ACTION:** We're not here just to be good. Go make something beautiful!

- **1. God is aesthetic in character.** (Gen. 1, Ps. 19:1; Eccl. 3:11; 1 Pet. 3:4)
  - The Early Church pioneered fine art, but then later marginalized it.
- 2. Artists are deeply valued by God
  - The wise hearted (Ex. 28:3, 35 25 KJV; 1 Chron. 15:16; 2 Chron. 1:5)
- 3. We are not here just to be good--go make something beautiful!
  - You have gifts to bring the Kingdom (Rom. 11:29; 1 Cor. 12-1-7; 1 Tim. 4:14-15)
  - You are God's masterpiece. (Ps. 139:14; Eph. 2:10)
