Romans 5:12-21

Because He lives we have a new identity, one no longer defined by sin, but by grace

We have a **default** sin nature

Sin is not just a behavior, it's a condition we inherit

Our old identity is shaped by sin, brokenness, and worst of all, separation from God

We don't have to live **condemned**, because He lives we can live **chosen**

Through Jesus we are given a new identity. one that is greater than sin or any of life's storms that we may face

Grace is not just enough, it's MORE than enough

Grace does more than save us, it **defines** us

Grace doesn't just change our destination, it changes our definition

Romans 5:20 Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more
