Understanding what the therefore is therefore

Word of God / Words of God

Rom 8 studied in context shows security for the believer in his sanctification not his justification

We believe in eternal security, however we should not take the Bible out of context to prove it

John 5:24 uses the word "condemnation" and makes reference to eternal life

We can't compare these 2 verses because it would be reading the past into the present and the context is making reference to everlasting life according to the new covenant

The phrase "in Christ Jesus" is a reference to sanctification in vs 1

The references in this passage that refer to the believers walk and mind are areas that are choices of the believer going back to the end of Ch 7

There is a difference between the believer being sealed by the Spirit at Justification until glorification and the "dwelling" based upon whether we are in the flesh or in the Spirit

Sanctification

Rom 8: 9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

10 ¶ And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Justification

Eph 1: 13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

Eph 4: 30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

II Cor 1: 22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
