Manuscript evidence is simply the examining of textual manuscripts for evidence of authenticity and purity

The two lines of manuscripts are not the same
The differences

Matt 1:25

25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS. (KJV)

25 and knew her not till she had brought forth a son: and he called his name JESUS. (ASV)

The Greek word is omitted, it is not a translation issue

Matt 6:13

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. (KJV)

13 And lead us not into temptation, But deliver us from evil. (RSV)

Matt 17:21

21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting. (KJV)

Matt 23:14

14 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation. (KJV)

Matthew 23:13 Some manuscripts add here (or after verse 12) verse 14: Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you devour widows' houses and for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you will receive the greater condemnation

Matt 27:35

35 And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots. (KJV)

35 And when they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots; (RSV)

[Mark 16:8](#) Some manuscripts have the following ending between verses 8 and 9, and one manuscript has it after verse 8 (omitting verses 9-20): *Then they quickly reported all these instructions to those around Peter. After this, Jesus himself also sent out through them from east to west the sacred and imperishable proclamation of eternal salvation. Amen.*
