



# The Door, The Road, The RSVP






# Opening the Door

- Do you have any kind of spiritual belief?
- To you, who is Jesus?
- Do you think there is a heaven and a hell?
- If you died right now, where would you go? Why?
- If what you believe were not true,  
would you want to know?





## Keep it Natural...

- Adjust wording to fit you
  - Example - question #5
- Don't argue
- Listen carefully
- If they are open:


“I'd like to share a few verses (from the Bible) with you”



# Walking the Road

How it works...

- Bible App, Sharing Bible or a Note
- Have them read the verse *out loud*
- Ask “What does it say to you?”
- Pray as they read
- Can clarify or highlight a word or thought



# The Verses

#1 Romans 3:23

#2 Romans 6:23


*Can clarify: death, and sin. Also, "gift".*

#3 Romans 5:8

#4 Romans 10:9, 13


*Can emphasize: He rose again, in Heaven until return, "everyone"*

Other verses: John 14:6 (after #3), Rev. 3:20 (after #4)



# The RSVP Moment

1. Are you a sinner?
2. Do you want forgiveness of sins?
3. Do you believe Jesus died for your sins and rose again?
4. Are you willing to surrender your life to Jesus Christ and trust Him as your Lord and Savior?



## If they Say YES

- Lead them in prayer

*The prayer itself does not save*


- Re-affirm forgiveness, relationship

*Romans 8:1, Rev. 3:20, 2 Cor. 5:17*

- Encourage next steps

*Colossians 2:6–7, 1 John 1:9, Psalm 119:10*

*Is there a close friend/family member they know?*



## If They're Not Ready

- Don't pressure...thank them
- Keep the relationship
- Trust God with the timing
- Suggest a Bible App, a gospel to read
