G. Campbell Morgan: "The doctrine of the inner light is not sufficiently taught. - 4. Circumstances (Prov 16:9; Eph 2:10)
- **5. Emotions** (Phil 4:6-7; Neh 8:10)
- **6. Desires** (Ps 37:4; Phil 2:13)
- **7.** Scripture (Heb 4:12)

The Bible is:

- Inspired (2Tim 3:16-17; 2Pet 1:20-21)
- Inerrant & Infallible (Prov 30:5; Jn 17:17)
- Absolutely Authoritative (Mt 5:17-19)
- Complete (Rev 22:18-19; Jude 3)

How do I know if God is really speaking to me?

We have to learn to recognize God's voice:

- The example of Samuel (1Sam 3:1-10)
- The example of Elijah (1Ki 19:11-13)

6 Principles for Recognizing God's Voice:

- 1. Does this agree with the clear teaching of Scripture?
- 2. Does this align with God's character?
- 3. Does this cater to my sinful desires or selfish motives?
- 4. Does this produce peace in my soul? (Jn 14:27)
- 5. Is this convicting... or condemning?
- 6. Is this clear... or confusing?
