### II. ITS CREATOR

- A. Jealousy is an attribute of God (Ex. 20:5; Josh. 24:19; Nah. 1:2).
- B. Jealousy is one of the names of God (Ex. 34:14).
- C. A jealous God chose to give this same attribute to man, as a great benefit to man (Num. 25:13).
- D. God loves and even rewards the proper use of jealousy (2 Cor. 11:2).
- E. Even the sinless Jesus Christ exhibited godly jealousy (John 2:17)
  - John 2:17 "Zeal (i.e., godly jealousy) for Your house will consume Me."
- F. Jealousy is a God-given emotion.
  - 1. Jealousy generates energy to protect and to possess! (Numbers 25:6-13; 2 Cor. 11:2-3).
  - 2. Jealousy is the most intense of all the emotions (Prov. 27:4; Psalm 79:5; Deut. 4:24; Zephaniah 1:18; 1 Corinthians 10:22; Song of Sol. 8:6).
  - 3. How did jealousy become the monster that consumes us? (Prov. 6:34-35; Gen. 4:3-5, 8; 1 John 3:12).

- A. Sinful jealousy prompts us to fight and quarrel (Jas. 4:2b).
- B. Sinful jealousy prompts us to murder (Jas. 4:2a; Mark 15:1).
- C. Sinful jealousy prompts us to discredit people who are more successful (Acts 13:44-45).
- D. Sinful jealousy prompts us to do cruel things to people (Acts 7:9; Rom. 1:29; Gal. 5:19-21).

### IV. ITS FATE

- A. Our lives can become a chaotic mess (Jas. 3:16).
- B. Our relationships can start to break down.
- C. Our lives can fill with anger and bitterness (Luke 15:25-30).
- D. Our lives can be robbed of joy and contentment.
- E. We stop growing as Christians (1 Cor. 3:1-3).
