5-10 years?"

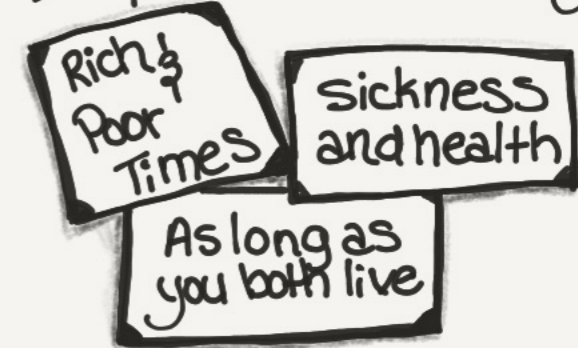
Is more about pursuit than perfection.
