These are the proverbs of Solomon, David's son, King of Israel.

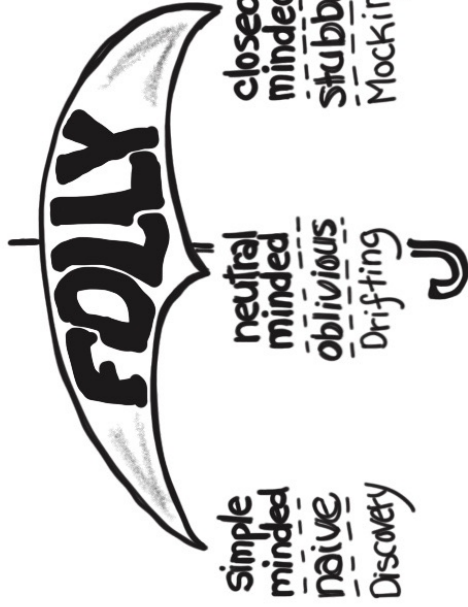
Their purpose is to take the insights of the wise and teach people to live successful lives, and to help them do what is right, just and fair.

Wisdom is the harmony of knowledge and skill.

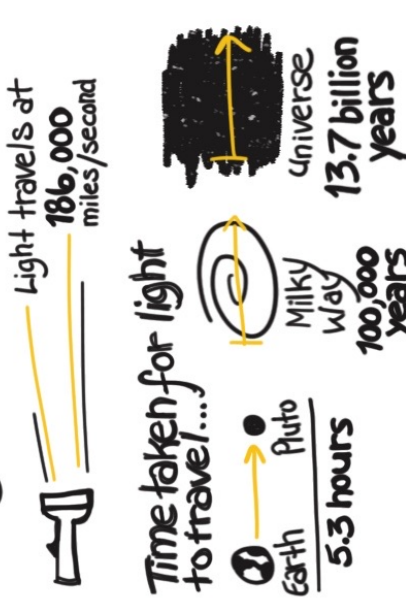


Fools do not fear God.
