Fear forces a reaction



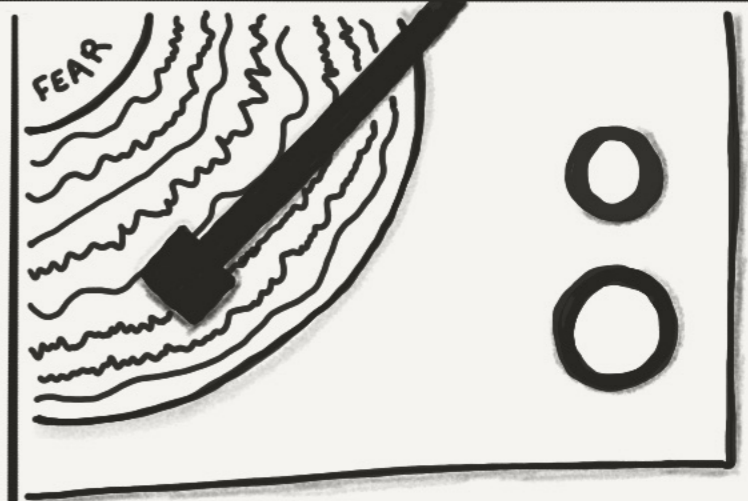
The disciples were stuck in the situation with no way out. They had no other option than to run to Him for help. When fear is forcing you to run, run to Him.
