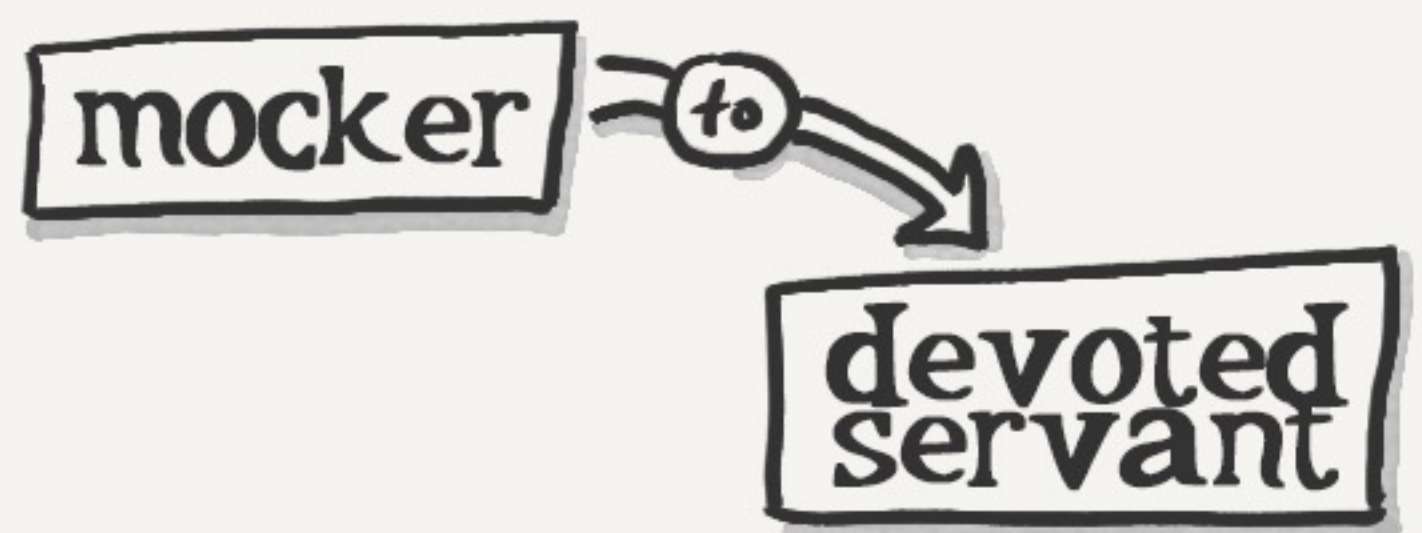

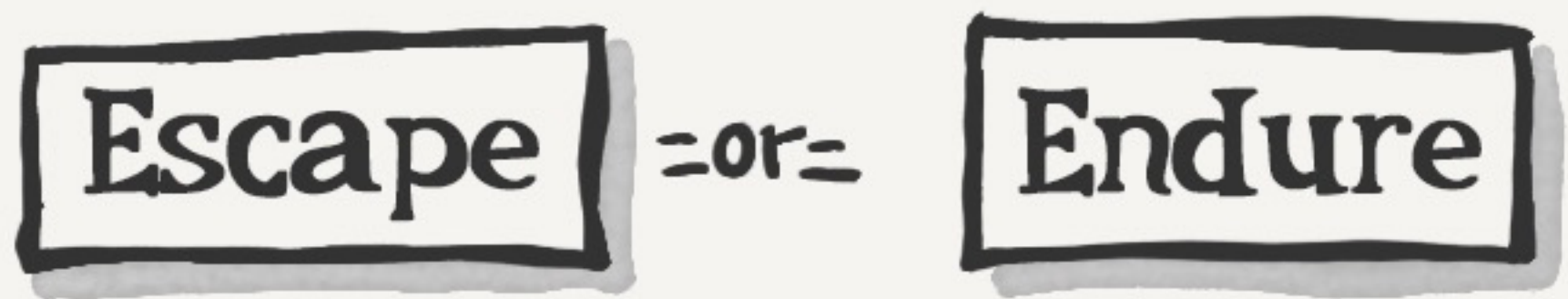

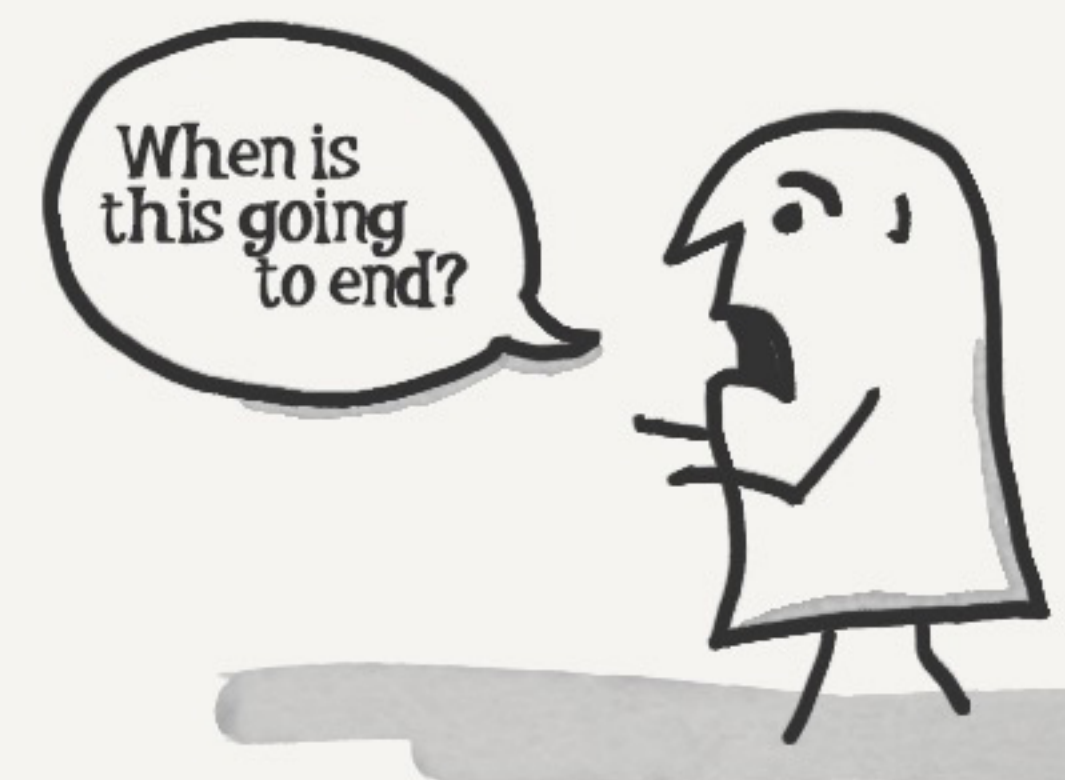


Double-mindedness

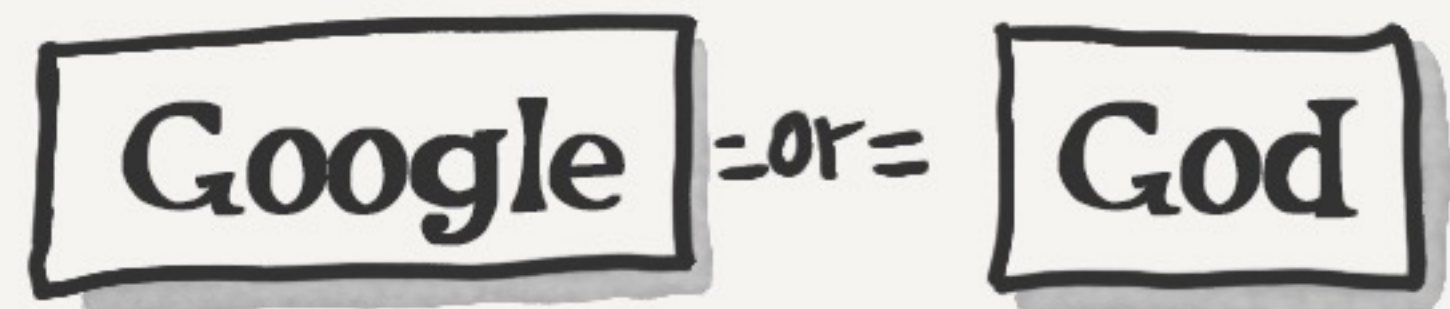
- Monday = Diet
