## V. 7-8

Jesus takes the scroll and then was he does all of creation and the Church bow down but this is now the redeemed creation and Church. This means those things that God has brought back to Him. We know this from what we talked about a couple of weeks ago. However the scriptures where creation and the Church are understood to not fully be in right standing with God, comes from the New Testament.

Creation –\_\_\_\_\_- we have the story of the temptation of Christ. Satan talks about giving him the thrones of the nations and this is symbolism. Satan was in the world and had control of it. But now creation is redeemed herein the throne room.

Church- \_\_\_\_\_- this is proof that before Christ the covenant in itself did not save the people. It was after Christ fulfillment of the covenant that his people were redeemed.

IN v 8- we see that everyone has

1. Harp- the harp and the lyre throughout the psalms and parts of the Old

Testament are representative of \_\_\_\_\_\_. The Jews would have been able to visualize this clearly as it was apart of their culture

2. Gold bowl of incense- these were items used in the time of sacrifice in the temple to be part of worship and communication of \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the people's sins. Now it is representative of the prayers that in Christ can bring before the throne freely.

In v 12 "a" means the one voice of all of these things. We will all be united in

V 12 Break down of 12

Under the earth- this is reference to Hades again- the abode of the dead. Before Christ Death, burial, and resurrection the side of hades that was for

the condemned was hopeless and could not praise God.(Psalms 6:5, Psalms 30:9) however when Jesus died it talks about him sharing the gospel there 1 Peter 3:18- 20. In light of this they can now join in the praise of Christ. These were the people in death before Christ, which is why Noah is referenced.
