Text: (Pick different people to read each passage.)

- 1. Proverbs 22:7
 - a. Just as the rich rule the poor, so the borrower is servant to the lender.
- 2. Matthew 6:24
 - a. "No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.
- 3. Joshua 24:14-15
 - a. "So fear the LORD and serve him wholeheartedly. Put away forever the idols your ancestors worshiped when theylived beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD alone. 15But if you refuse to serve the LORD, then choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the LORD."

Group Questions: (Have 3-4 people answer each question.)

- 1. Do you feel like your finances are serving you (i.e. creating space for debt free vacations, date nights, family adventures, etc.)? Why or why not?
- 2. Do you feel financially secure? Why or why not?
- 3. If you are in debt, what has stopped you from getting out of it?
- 4. If you are out of debt, what did you proactively do to achieve that?
