SUMMARY

ICEBREAKER

What aspect of your personality adds the most value to the world?

SCRIPTURE

- Proverbs 7:6-27 The naive young man.
- Acts 2:42-47 The Fellowship of the Believers

DISCUSSION

Read the scripture selections as a group. To help facilitate discussion you can ask questions like:

- What would you have done if you were in Solomon's place?
- If you were the Young Man, what would you have wanted Solomon to do before you went with the Woman? What about after?
- What does it mean, in Acts, to have fellowship?

Last week you and your group started writing down your Personal Values and a Mission statement. Go around the group and share things that stuck out to each of you. Also share the Values and Mission each of you want to live by.

 What are some things that your small group can do for each other to help see those Values and Mission come true?
