Icebreaker: What is the nerdiest fact you can remember?

Questions:

- Any action you can take is preceded by a belief that that action will get you what you want. *How do you feel about that statement? Do you agree or disagree and why?*
- Read Matthew 16:13-24
Jesus tells Peter (and by extension, us) he could not have gained the knowledge of Jesus's own divinity without divine help. *Discuss some implications of that statement. What does it tell you about your own faith in Christ?*
- Read James 2:14-17
James tells us that faith without works is dead or worthless. If you have faith, then your life will show it. *How is your life showing your faith that Jesus is in fact God? Discuss some areas where you would like to take more action to demonstrate your faith.*

Things to Consider:

- We build habits (tie your shoes, driving, etc.) so that our minds can be free to handle day to day living (dodge, study, etc.).
What sorts of habits would you like to build to help your soul (and therefore you) align with God?
- Your **Will** is the choice center of your life. *Are there choices you have made that have taken you away from the path you wanted to walk? If you submit your **Will** to Jesus, do you think you would make better choices?*

*At the end of the day, what we want is a better life and to be better at life. Submitting your **Will** to Jesus is the first step in putting God at the top of your TODO list. He wants the best for you **and** knows how to do it.*

Going Deeper: Will you continue conversing with your soul? Will you make it a habit?

Around the room: What is God saying or doing in your life right now?
