DISCUSSION

The Last Supper in **Luke** is our first introduction to communion. What stands out to you about this event? How have you treated communion in the past?

Paul reiterates in **1 Corinthians** the command Jesus gave at the "Last Supper". Do you feel like you can run communion at home?

INTRODUCTION

For what Christ did on the cross, we share the bread which is His body, and the wine which is His blood, to remember that sacrifice and victory over death.

METHOD

There are many ways to host a communion. Here's one suggestion:

Prepare the bread by dividing a

1. loaf into bite-sized pieces. Do the same for the wine or juice.

2. Pass these out and ask everyone to share what Christ's sacrifice has meant to them personally. Then eat and drink as a group.

3. After everyone has taken communion, spend some time as a group praying for each other, your families, and those on your hearts.
