Some example questions for this week:

2 Corinthians 5:11-21

- In verse 16, Paul makes a huge statement about how we are to treat and think of others.
 Do you find that challenging?
- How do you feel about being an ambassador to Heaven?

John 17:13-19

Jesus is praying to the Father for his disciples before he is arrested.

- Why do you think Jesus points out that His disciples are not of this world?
- Why would Jesus ask God protect us instead of simply taking us to Heaven?

It can be really easy for us to hide in a group (even if it's small). This week, let's stretch our discomfort muscles.

Jesus, who is our king, has a mission for us to represent truth to the world which so desperately needs it. But to be an ambassador, you need to know about, look, act, and be someone from where you represent. Basically live like your country of origin.
