DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

 - How would you react to having the angel Gabriel show up in your home?
 - How would you react to the news that Gabriel delivered? (unplanned pregnancy, unmarried, early teenager, etc.)
 - How did Mary react?
- 4. Now think back on the circumstances from #2. Do you think you could respond to your own situations as Mary did to hers in verse 38? Why or why not?

MOVING FORWARD

Joseph could have rejected Mary. Mary could have bemoaned the call on her life. Both of them could have lived like victims. Instead, their response was to look up; recognizing that not only was God with them, but that He was for them. We don't get to choose our circumstances, only our responses.
