



What does “Spiritual Praxis” Mean?

SPIRITUAL = God’s Spirit shaping who you are on the inside. Growing a real relationship with God that shapes who you are and how you live.

PRAXIS = The process of using a theory or something that you have learned in a practical way. It means living out what you say you believe.

Read

Spend time reading a portion of scripture. Use one from your daily reading plan or choose one of these passages.

Psalm 16 – Psalm 19 – Matthew 7 – Luke 4 – 1 John 4

Meditation

Engage in a 3 minute “Prayer Pause” meditation from the app or slowly read through the mediation provided on the back page.

Pray (Use these ideas or use your own prayer list!)

God, help me with what feels heavy right now.

God, what’s something I need to let go of and trust You with?

Father, show me one way I can love others better this week.

Silence

Sit in silence for 5 minutes. Listen for the voice of God. Listen for things of faith, hope and love to pop up in your thoughts.
