The Holy Spirit

Numbers 11:29 I wish that all the Lord's people were prophets,
and that the Lord would put His spirit upon them all.

Acts 2:16 No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: In the last days, God says, I will pour out my spirit on all people. **Your sons and daughters will prophesy**, your young men will see visions...

“...your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams.”

“Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, **and they will prophesy.**”

1 Thessalonians 5:19 Do not put out the Spirit's fire; Do not treat prophecies with contempt.....

....Test everything. Hold on to the good.

22 He who finds a wife finds what is good and receives favor from the LORD. **Proverbs 18**

3 questions to ask for every conversation and decision.

1. What can I say to help them keep going and strengthen them?

What would happen if we would ask God in every conversation we have, “God, do they need strengthening?”

2. What has God spoken to them that I can confirm?

3. What pain have they experienced that God wants to comfort?

2. Prophecy is Miraculous.

²⁴ But if an unbeliever or an inquirer comes in while everyone is prophesying, they are convicted of sin and are brought under judgment by all, ²⁵ as the secrets of their hearts are laid bare. So they will fall down and worship God, exclaiming, “God is really among you!”

Prophecy – a word of God spoken in the right time, in the right setting. It's miraculous.
