¹ In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

-Genesis 1:1-2 (ESV)

Genesis 1 is a foundational passage in the Bible. But here's what you need to understand: **Genesis tells us WHO created... but not exactly WHEN or HOW.**

The “*who*” is clear—**God**. But the “*when*” and “*how*” are **NOT** the focus of the text.

Here are two important points to keep in mind:

First, Genesis is written in the language of description—not modern scientific explanation.

That doesn't mean the Bible and science are enemies. It just means Genesis isn't trying to be a science textbook. It's not anti-science—it's pre-science.

Second, no human being was there when creation happened—not even Moses.

So again – Genesis points us to the **Creator**, even if it doesn't spell out every detail of the process.

“So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.”

-Genesis 1:27 (ESV)

“None of you shall approach any one of his close relatives to uncover nakedness. I am the LORD.”

-Leviticus 18:6
