Who Is He? Let's Remember His Names:

- Alpha and Omega – He is the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last (Revelation 22:13).
- El Shaddai (God Almighty) – There is nothing our God cannot do (Genesis 17:1).
- El Elyon (Most High God) – He is higher than our pain, our problems, and anything else we face (Psalm 57:2).
- Yahweh (The Great I Am) – He is the One who was, who is, and who always will be (Exodus 3:14; Hebrews 1:1).
- Yahweh Rapha (The Lord Who Heals) – He is our healer and the One who makes us whole (Exodus 15:26).
- Yahweh Jireh (The Lord Who Provides) – He meets all our needs according to His glorious riches (Genesis 22:14).
- Yahweh Nissi (The Lord Our Banner) – He fights our battles and gives us victory (Exodus 17:15).
- Yahweh Shalom (The Lord Our Peace) – He calms every storm and gives us peace in the midst of chaos (Judges 6:24).
- Yahweh Ra'ah (The Lord My Shepherd) – He leads, feeds, guides, and provides (Psalm 23:1).
- Yahweh Tsidkenu (The Lord Our Righteousness) – He became our sin and gave us His righteousness (Jeremiah 23:5-6).
- Yahweh Shammah (The Lord Who Is There) – He is always present and will never leave us (Ezekiel 48:35; Hebrews 13:6).
- Emmanuel (God With Us) – Jesus, God in the flesh, came to dwell among us (Matthew 1:23; John 1:14).
- Jesus – The name above every name, the only name by which we must be saved (Philippians 2:9-11; Acts 4:12).
- Lamb of God – He takes away the sins of the world (John 1:29).
- Good Shepherd – He laid down His life for the sheep (John 10:11).
- Light of the World – He shines into our darkness (John 8:12).
- Bread of Life – He satisfies the deepest needs of our soul (John 6:35).
- King of Kings and Lord of Lords – At His name, every knee will bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord (Philippians 2:10-11; Revelation 19:1).
