

4. **Digging Deeper:** This Sunday, Pastor Terry shared the story of Jesus giving the life of the son back to the widow found in Luke 7:11-17. She didn't ask for Jesus to come. She didn't recognize who he was. She didn't even ask for her son to be healed but Jesus was compelled by compassion and love. How is our focus on the next life and on the love of Jesus enable us to love others the same way that Jesus did?

a. What are you willing to do to make sure you can make this temporary life of hardship, pain, and loss not get the best of you?

b. Share with the group of what "Garden of Gethsemane" moment might be trying to get best of you. What would be your response to others of how to overcome this moment? What might you need from your group now to help you overcome this moment?

c. What would be some healthy practices or spiritual habits that will allow for you to stay faithful and obedient in these times of trial, sorrow, or hardships?

d. Is there anything you need to do as a result of what you've learned this week?

Closing in prayer: Close in a time of prayer this week. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you if there is anything that may be keeping you or others from experiencing the love and forgiveness of Jesus because of the time we have lived in this temporary life.
