1. What's one thing from last weekend's sermon that you hope we talk about as a group?

Share what scriptures have helped you through these hard times whenever relevant.
a. A time of rejection.
b. A time of regret.
c. A time of insecurity.

d. A time of worry.

4. <u>Digging Deeper</u> : Pastor Terry spoke on the importance of keeping the word of God close, to keep his blueprint for building bridges our focus. He shared the passages of scripture from David, Jeremiah, and Joshua of their importance of keeping the word of God on their minds and in their hearts. What are some applicable suggestions that you feel might be beneficial to this group and to this church to help us keep the teachings and commands of Jesus a priority?
a. How does remembering or studying these blueprints help us become bridge builders?
b. Share with the group why it might be difficult for you to apply the teachings and commands of Jesus.
c. What would be some healthy practices or spiritual habits that might allow for you to learn how to "meditate on the Lord's words day and night."
d. Is there anything you need to do as a result of what you've learned this week?
