Luke 19:1-10 NIV

1. Take time to catch up this week! How was your break? Have each person share two things: Favorite experience since break and share something new about yourself that others may not know about.
2. What is one thing from last weekend's sermon that you hope we talk about as a group?
3. Share of a time in your life where you got lost and found it very difficult to find your way back home. How did you feel and how did you find your way back?
4. In reading Luke 19:1-10, we see that Jesus is making himself available to those in the crowd and to Zacchaeus. Jesus said, "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." In your own life, how can we, as followers of Christ, have this same commitment? What are some actions we can take? Pastor Terry said it this way, "Climb a tree...do extra ordinary things to see extraordinary results." (i.e. Backyard BBQ and invite co-workers and neighbors).

5. **Digging Deeper:** In order to see Jesus, Zacchaeus was willing to do something out of the ordinary, just to get a glimpse. Jesus, in order to save Zacchaeus, all he did was to invite him over for lunch. Share of a time in your life where others simple act of love and/or faithfulness got you out of a tough situation or brought you to Jesus? How did this time and experience move you to do the same for others?
