 - b. Dealing with grief of a close loved one or friend.
 - c. Needing to support/wisdom with a family member or spouse.

5. As a home group, how can we better support one another to be more vulnerable and more authentic in our relationships? What are some of your thoughts on how being more real and authentic with others affects your relationship with God?

6. Times of fear of being seen for who you really are can be very difficult and needing to overcome times where we got hurt because we may have shared too much or shared with unsafe people. Who are some of the people you can trust now in order to be practiced at being more vulnerable and authentic? Is there anything you are going through right now that your home group could be praying for and helping with, if they only knew about it?
