## A Famine in America?

### Amos 8:11

## I. <u>A Nation Without the Bible is</u> <u>Without Freedom.</u>

### John 8:32

"And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

A. "The Truth shall make you free."

B. History reveals the Bible brings freedom.

II. <u>A Nation Without the Bible is</u> Without Foundations.

(<u>Matthew 7:24-29</u>) A. <u>The life or land built on God's Word - Stands.</u>

- B. Apart from God's Word, there is not absolutes.
  - Judges 21:25 "Everyone did what was right in his own eyes."
- C. The Bible provides us with a moral compass.

Deut. 30:15 & 19 "See, I set before you today life and good, death and evil...<sup>19</sup>I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live..."

D. We must get back to the Bible in our Land.

# III. <u>A Nation Without the Bible is</u> Without Faith.

(Romans 10:17)

#### A. Paul describes this problem in his own nation.

- <u>Romans 10:1-4</u>, Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved.
- <sup>2</sup>For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.
- <sup>3</sup>For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God.
- <sup>4</sup>For Christ is the end of the law for righterusness to everyone who believes.

#### B. The Bible imparts seeds of faith.

<u>1 Peter 1:22-23</u>, Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,

<sup>23</sup>having been born again, not of corruptible <u>seed</u> but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever.

C. <u>Neglecting the Bible is like having a famine for God's Word.</u> Amos 4:6-13 – selected verses.

D. Great national wealth is found in the faith of its people.
