Reaching the Outcast

John 4:4-26

I. Jesus listens well to the Father's leading.

(John 3:4-6)

- A. Jesus needed to go through Samaria. (V. 4)
- B. But, Jesus 'needed' to go there anyway.

 "needed to" = 'it was necessary to.'
- C. Partiality is sinful, but Jesus was not partial.

V.6 Jesus ... being wearied...

II. Jesus cared for all the woman's needs.

(<u>vv. 7-22</u>)

A. What were her needs that Jesus cared for?

Yet Jesus cared for her *emotional needs* (vv. 7-12).

Jesus cared for her *physical needs*.

Jesus cared for her *spiritual needs* (vv.15-18).

Jesus showed His care for her *intellectual needs* (vv.19-26).

III. Jesus Reveals to her the truth. (vv. 23-26)

- A. Jesus opened her eyes to see the truth. (v. 23)
 - John 17: 3, "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true and living God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent."
- B. Jesus revealed this is His Father's desire. (v. 24)
- C. Jesus clarifies the woman's confusion about Him. (vv.25-26)
 - "I, who speak to you am He."
