#### WHAT MATTERS TO GOD WHEN YOU PRAY?

### 1. YOUR <u>RELATIONSHIPS</u> MATTER.

Mark 11:24-25 "Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for <u>in</u> <u>prayer</u>; believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. 25 And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, <u>forgive them</u>, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins." (NIV)

1 Peter 3:7 Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with <u>respect</u> as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that <u>nothing will</u> <u>hinder your prayers</u>. (NIV)

### 2. YOUR MOTIVES MATTER.

James 4:3 *When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives*... (NIV)

Proverbs 16:2 *All a person's ways seem pure to them, but <u>motives</u> <i>are weighed by the LORD*. (NIV)

## 3. THE WAY YOU <u>LIVE</u> MATTERS.

James 5:16b ... *The prayer of a <u>righteous</u> person is <u>powerful and</u> <u>effective</u>. (NIV)* 

Proverbs 15:29 *The LORD is far from the wicked, but he hears the prayer of the <u>righteous</u>. (NIV)* 

## 4. YOUR FAITH MATTERS.

James 1:6-7 But when you ask, you must <u>believe and not doubt</u>, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. 7 That person should not expect to <u>receive</u> <u>anything from the Lord</u>. (NIV)

Matthew 9:29-30 *Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your <u>faith</u> let it be done to you"; 30 and their sight was restored. (NIV)* 

# 5. GOD'S <u>WILL</u> MATTERS.

1 John 5:14-15 *This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything <u>according to his will</u>, he hears us. 15 And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him. (NIV)* 

Luke 22:42 "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not <u>my will</u>, but <u>yours be done</u>." (NIV)
