# SACRED COW TIPPING #14 "Using Our Tongues for Good" August 25, 2019 1 Corinthians 14

Edification: to build each other up.

1 Corinthians 14:1-5 Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy.<sup>2</sup> For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit. <sup>3</sup> But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort. <sup>4</sup> Anyone who speaks in a tongue edifies themselves, but the one who prophesies edifies the church. <sup>5</sup> I would like every one of you to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be edified.

• A spiritual gift is an <u>ability</u> provided by God to <u>equip</u> Christians to do ministry for Jesus just like Jesus.

Tongues: means languages.

### Two expressions of Tongues:

- 1. Missionary Gift (Acts 2)
- 2. Prayer Language (Romans 8:22)

## Two misuses of Tongues:

- 1. When someone <u>imposes</u> it on others and suggests that they may be less of a Christian if they've never done or experienced it. (Acts 4:31)
- 2. When someone turns it into something <u>selfish</u> by pursuing it for the feeling of when they experience it.

**Prophecy:** means to speak <u>clearly</u> before others or speaking the <u>Word of God</u> clearly.

#### (1 Corinthians 14:6-33a)

- Everything said and done should be in an effort to build up the church, not yourself.
- Everything is done in an orderly way.
- If a different language is spoken, it should be interpreted so that we understand it.
- If there is not an interpretation, stay silent and pray quietly to yourself and to God.
- When someone prophecies (preaching/teaching), then everyone else should check it.

(1 Corinthians 14:33b-40)

#### **Three Reasons the Church Meets:** (1 Corinthians 14:3)

- 1. Strengthening or Edification: to build each other up
- 2. <u>Encouraging</u> or Exhortation: to be encouraged in a new kind of behavior
- 3. <u>Comforting</u> or Consolation: to be comforted in our hurts and setbacks
