

# 2 Corinthians 5:16-6:2

This section of Scripture is Straight Up Gospel. There's nothing more important than this right here!

### Title: "Gospel Realities"

#### The New Creation (verse 17)

V. 17 - If <u>anyone</u> is <u>in Christ</u> - To be "In Christ" is available to "ANYONE" - Are you <u>in Adam</u> or <u>in Christ</u>?
V. 17 - He is a <u>new creation</u> - Those in Christ are <u>completely new creatures</u>! Think of <u>Paul's Life</u>...
V. 17 - <u>Old things have passed away</u> - In Christ means the "old things" (the <u>penalty of sin</u>) are over.
V. 17 - Behold, all things have <u>become new</u> - You're also <u>made new</u> and welcome <u>into God's Family</u>!
\*As <u>NEW CREATURES</u> - "I used to chase sin, but now sin chases me" - How does that minister to you?

### The New Outlook (verse 16)

V. 16 - From now on we regard <u>no one according to the flesh</u> - We don't have a "worldly" view anymore.
V. 16 - Even though we have known <u>Christ according to the flesh</u> - Check out <u>Matthew 16:13-16</u>
V. 16 - Yet now we know Him <u>thus no longer</u> - Read <u>Philippians 3:4-8</u> to see Paul's testimony of this,
\*As <u>NEW CREATURES</u> - We now view Jesus and all the people of this world differently. In what ways?

#### The Restored Relationship (verses 18a, 19a)

V. 18 - Now all things are of God - Creation & Salvation - they are all <u>initiated by God</u>. They are <u>gifts</u>.
V. 18 - Who has <u>reconciled us</u> to Himself - To be reconciled implies <u>there's a problem</u> - <u>Romans 5:12</u>
V. 19 - <u>Through Jesus Christ</u> - <u>Born</u> in <u>Adam</u> is the <u>problem</u> | <u>Born again</u> through <u>Jesus</u> is the <u>answer</u>!
V. 19 - <u>Not imputing</u> their trespasses to them - Our sins are <u>JUSTIFIED</u> through Jesus. <u>Romans 5:1</u>
\*As <u>NEW CREATURES</u> - We have been forgiven much & now have peace with God. Comments?

#### The Glorious Ministry (verses 18b, 19b, 20)

V. 18 - And as given us the <u>ministry of reconciliation</u> - We are all in <u>full time ministry</u>. A responsibility!
V. 19 - Committed to us the <u>word</u> of reconciliation - And, it is a "spoken" ministry. <u>Romans 10:14-15</u>
V. 20 - Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ - We are Christ's "representatives" here on Earth.
V. 20 - As though God were pleading through us - The Lord desires that none would perish. <u>2 Peter 3:9</u>
V. 20 - We implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God - Our ministry is <u>not timid</u>, but <u>BOLD</u>
\*As <u>NEW CREATURES</u> - We have been given a huge privilege & responsibility. How do we live it out?

#### The Great Exchange (verse 21)

V. 21 - For He made Him who knew no sin - Jesus was <u>born without sin</u> and <u>never sinned</u>. SPOTLESS!
V. 21 - To be sin for us - He took <u>our sin</u> and the <u>wrath of the Father</u> upon himself. SUBSTITUTE!
V. 21 - That we might become the righteousness of God In Him - It just keeps getting better!
\*As <u>NEW CREATURES</u> - We understand all that Jesus bore on our behalf - What does this stir up?

# The Urgent Plea (chapter 16, verses 1-2)

V. 1 - We then, as workers together with Him - We work with Christ as His ambassadors...

- V. 1 Plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain Receive this message and LIVE IT OUT!
- V. 2 "In an acceptable time I have heard you; in the day of salvation I have helped you" <u>Isaiah 49:8</u>
- *V.* 2 Now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation This is an **URGENT** plea!
- \*As **<u>NEW CREATURES</u>** We know that time is short; day is at hand. What does your mission look like?
