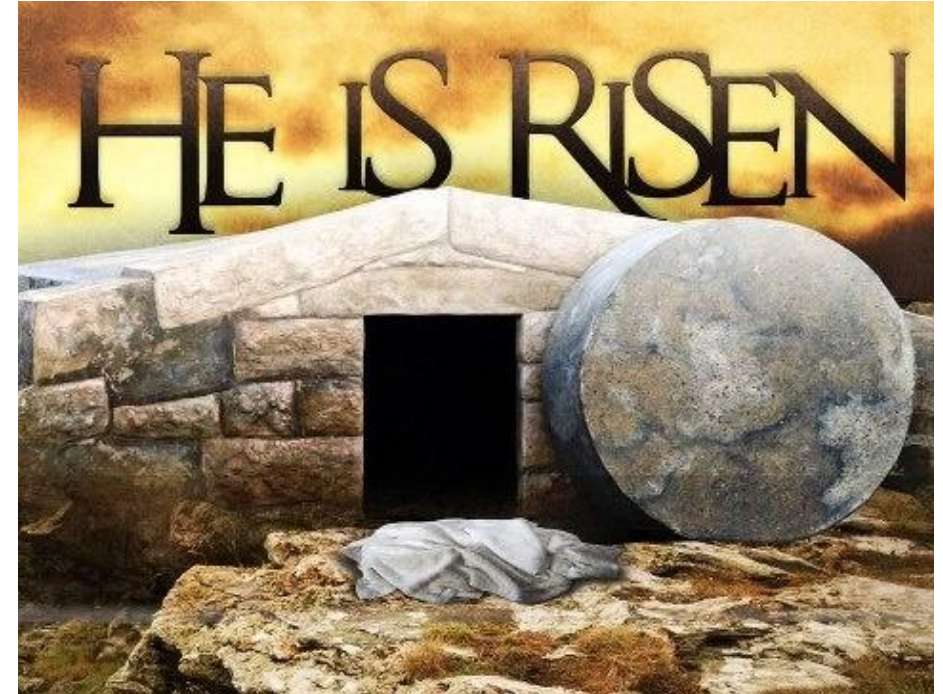

Word from our Pastor



Praises be unto God for the great things He hath done.

On this Sunday, we celebrate Easter or Resurrection Sunday. It's a day of profound joy and celebration as we turn from the cross to stand and gaze at an empty tomb and hear proclaimed the most amazing news for all ages: "He is not here, He has risen!" Resurrection or Easter Sunday is also a day for us to acknowledge a number of objective facts:

1. Jesus died on a Roman cross by crucifixion; Jesus was buried in a tomb not far from the crucifixion site;
2. Jesus' death threw his disciples into a state of despair and despondency;
3. Jesus tomb was discovered to be empty shortly after His burial;

They looked for his body, but have not been able to find it for 2026 years;

4. The disciples had real and genuine experiences that convinced them beyond a shadow of a doubt that Jesus had risen from the dead;
5. Their experience caused them to go in some cases, like that of Peter, from being cowards to being bold witnesses of Jesus to the point of death; and
6. The resurrection was foundational to the birth of the church and the church has grown and is still growing worldwide based upon Christ' resurrection. We celebrate these facts, however as the Church, our faith isn't based just upon the facts only. Our faith is rooted and grounded in our own personal experience with the Lord. Indeed, this is what the Apostle Paul spell out in the 15th chapter of his letter to the church at Corinth (1 Corinthians 15:1-10). He shares the facts about Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, and most importantly he shares that he's experienced the Lord Jesus Christ for himself! Indeed, our challenge as the Church, on this Resurrection Sunday, and each and every day, is to be like the Apostle Paul and to accept the challenge of making the Gospel real. Our calling is to make Jesus' story our story. We do this, by understanding that God has called us, in the words of Jesus, to proclaim good news to the poor; he has sent u to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, and to set the oppressed free (Luke 4:18).

Therefore let us press forward to not only make a difference but to be the difference!

Church Covenant in Response Service

"And they entered into a covenant to seek the Lord God of their Fathers with all their heart and soul." (II Chronicles 15:12)

Minister: *What common experience leads us into spiritual fellowship and covenant relations with God and one another?*

Congregation: To walk circumspectly in the world; to be just in our dealings, faithful in our engagements, and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid all tattling, backbiting, and excessive anger; to abstain from the sale and the use of intoxicating drinks as a beverage, and to be zealous in our effort to advance the kingdom of our Savior.

Minister: *Since One is our Master, even Christ and all we are brethren, by what fraternal ministries are we to strengthen each other and adorn the teachings of our Lord?*

Congregation: We further engage to watch over each other in brotherly love and watchfulness; giving and receiving admonition with meekness and affection; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rule of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

Minister: *For the good of our own Spiritual development, and for the best interest of the Master's kingdom, what do we promise to do if we move beyond the reach of this church?*

Congregation: We moreover engage that when we remove from this place, we will, as soon as possible, unite with some other church of this faith, where we can carry out the spirit of this Covenant and the principles of God's Word.

All: *Humbly confessing our past sins, we pray for grace and strength to keep these, our holy vows, for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen*
