Written to Jewish Christians scattered due to persecution (James 1:1).



They faced social rejection, economic hardship, and religious pressure.

9:

"Trials" = both external pressures (persecution) and internal tests (temptation).



James is teaching that trials aren't setbacks—they're set-ups for growth.
