In the midst of elections, sickness, deaths, and challenges we still have Joy!

During the past months we have witnessed the fruit of the spirit growing the midst of our awesome congregation. As we have matured we have seen in each of you the manifestation of His "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." Recognizing that those who are in Christ are distinguished from unbelievers in that they have been gifted with the Holy Spirit, enabling them to bear these fruit (Gal.5:22-23).

In this final month of the year we are engaged in the preparation for the season of Advent.

The Advent season is a four week period before Christmas that celebrates the anticipation and coming of Jesus Christ, the Messiah. The origin of "advent" is from the Latin word *adventus* which simply translates "coming" or "arrival". Not only is the Christian meaning for preparation and celebration of the coming of Jesus Christ, his birth at Christmas, but also to celebrate the new life when someone accepts Jesus Christ as their Savior, and lastly, the anticipation of Jesus returning again.

There are beautiful and rich traditions behind the celebration of Advent. Join us as we take a deeper look and focus on the themes of each week of Advent and some of the traditions celebrated around the world during the Advent season. May each of us find time to slow down this Christmas season, say "no" to the things that distract you from Jesus and say "yes" to the gift that God wants you to experience. The four candles of the Advent wreath represent hope, peace, joy, salvation or love.

The hope candle is used to teach us about the prophesy of the Lord's first coming.

The Peace candle is used to teach us about how Christ is the Prince of Peace.

The Joy candle is for the joy the shepherds expressed because their prayers for the messianic age had been answered.

The candle of salvation or love is an expression of God's love for humankind.

The center candle is the Christ candle, and it is lit when all others have been lit. Therefore as Christ shines His light upon us let us, shine our light on others. We invite you to anticipate and prepare for the coming of Christ not only during this season but throughout the year. "Come walk with us for we will do you good!"

Minister: Since One is our Master, even Christ and all we are brethren, by what fraternal ministries are we to strengthen each other and adorn the teachings of our Lord?

Congregation: We further engage to watch over each other in brotherly love and watchfulness; giving and receiving admonition with meekness and affection; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rule of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

Minister: For the good of our own Spiritual development, and for the best interest of the Master's kingdom, what do we promise to do if we move beyond the reach of this church?

Congregation: We moreover engage that when we remove from this place, we will, as soon as possible, unite with some other church of this faith, where we can carry out the spirit of this Covenant and the principles of God's Word.
