Word from our Pastor

Praises be unto God for the great things He hath done.

As we enter into this eleventh month of the year, I am reminded of the words of the writer of 1 Thessalonians 5:18, who states that "in all thing give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you". Additionally the song writer blasts that every day is a day of thanksgiving, therefore it's at this time of year that we raise the bar and refocus ourselves on being thankful and grateful for the many blessings bestowed upon each of us.

Often we are faced with the question of what gratitude really is, therefore in this month's greeting I will spend this time defining gratitude and stating some of my concerns relative to gratitude.

What is gratitude? Gratitude is the appreciation of benefits received. Gratitude is not happiness, a fleeting feeling from a particular circumstance. Gratitude is not conditional. I get something therefore I am thankful. I do not get something; therefore I am not thankful. Gratitude is not guilt. The story of starving children in the world might create guilt but not necessarily gratitude. Gratitude is not mind game, a psychological trick to vanquish difficult situations. Gratitude is a constant mentality that recognizes a benefit, its value and its source.

From The Book of Virtues to Plato's four virtues, one virtue is missing; gratitude. Though, lost gratitude is arguably the most important virtue. Researchers have demonstrated that gratitude is considered the parent of all virtues by Cicero, and actually improves psychological, relational, cognitive, and spiritual well-being. When gratitude is missing from the fabric of our lives, our lives are diminished.

Thankfulness and gratitude is not for God's fulfillment; it's for us. Gratitude infinitely improves our lives. Therefore let us constantly throughout each day engage ourselves in the practice of expressing thanks to God, Family, friends, strangers for their benefits in our lives. Remember " Every day is a day of Thanksgiving".

24 However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God’s grace.

25 “Now I know that none of you among whom I have gone about preaching the kingdom will ever see me again.

26 **Therefore, I declare to you today that I am innocent of the blood of any of you.**

27 For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the whole will of God.

28 **Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God,¹³ which he bought with his own blood.**

29 I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock.

30 **Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to draw away disciples after them.**

32 **Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.**

34 **You yourselves know that these hands of mine have supplied my own needs and the needs of my companions.**

35 In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive.’ ”

36 **When Paul had finished speaking, he knelt down with all of them and prayed.**

37 They all wept as they embraced him and kissed him.

38 **What grieved them most was his statement that they would never see his face again. Then they accompanied him to the ship.**

Minister: For the sake of the unsaved for whom Christ died to what manner of life and conversation are we solemnly pledged?

Congregation: To walk circumspectly in the world; to be just in our dealings, faithful in our engagements, and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid all tattling, backbiting, and excessive anger; to abstain from the sale and the use of intoxicating drinks as a beverage, and to be zealous in our effort to advance the kingdom of our Savior.

Minister: Since One is our Master, even Christ and all we are brethren, by what fraternal ministries are we to strengthen each other and adorn the teachings of our Lord?

Congregation: We further engage to watch over each other in brotherly love and watchfulness; giving and receiving admonition with meekness and affection; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rule of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

Minister: For the good of our own Spiritual development, and for the best interest of the Master's kingdom, what do we promise to do if we move beyond the reach of this church?

Congregation: We moreover engage that when we remove from this place, we will, as soon as possible, unite with some other church of this faith, where we can carry out the spirit of this Covenant and the principles of God's Word.

All: Humbly confessing our past sins, we pray for grace and strength to keep these, our holy vows, for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen
