Word from our Pastor



Praises be unto God for the great things He hath done.

As we enter into this Lenten season and our Journey to the Cross, I want to personally thank each who has taken seriously the intentionality of Prayer, Fasting and Giving.

I am convinced that our lives and endeavors can and will be much more peaceful and successful when we talk to God about our good and bad times.

As we face challenging times and circumstances in our lives and our nation, it is necessary to pray and fast if we want change to take place.

Therefore I am appealing to you make prayer and fasting a priority in our personal lives, homes, churches, schools, places of work and play.

Prayer should not only precede action, it is action; of the highest kind because it gives God the priority He deserves. Prayer and fasting must permeate our actions by being a continual part of our journey as we consciously live in His presence.

We must admit that we are easily distracted and we must fight to keep this perspective continually. It is not just a matter of making time for Him; it is the realization that all of our time is in His hands and that we are constantly before Him wherever we are whatever we do.

This is what it means to live day by day in a relationship with Him as Savior and Lord, and this realization helps us the fast and pray increasingly without ceasing.

Learning to give prayer and fasting higher priority takes time. It rarely happens immediately because we are steeped in self-reliance and self-actualization . We have within us unlearned old habits and patterns of thoughts and behaviors that can only be removed from our lives through these spiritual disciplines. Evan Roberts, a minister in the early 1900s, prayed and fast with real intensity, Oh Lord, bend me! Roberts was skilled as a blacksmith and he painted a picture of what happens when metal is forged on an anvil. Making more time for prayer and fasting can be like that. God works within our lives wills and bends us in new directions when we fast and pray.

Gently, over time, we find new peace and strength in His presence. God desires us to be fasting and prayerful people of action: people who pray and fast first and then act in response to His Leading. All of us are at varying stages of keeping this balance. Sometimes we tell ourselves, I am not much of a praying person. But because Jesus was a praying person, you and I are intended to become like Him. Because God loves us, sooner or later He will bring us to our knees to empty ourselves so He can fill us and use us. Prayer and action are two sides of the same coin of a mature and childlike faith. Action without prayer, even if its done for God, too often misses the mark. I again appeal to you to Make Prayer, fasting and Giving a Priority during this Lenten season! Let Us Follow Him and watch Him work in and through us!



Church Covenant in Response Service

"And they entered into a covenant to seek the Lord God of their Fathers with all their heart and soul." (II Chronicles 15:12)

Minister: *What common experience leads us into spiritual fellowship and covenant relations with God and one another?*

Minister: *For the sake of the unsaved for whom Christ died to what manner of life and conversation are we solemnly pledged?*

Congregation: To walk circumspectly in the world; to be just in our dealings, faithful in our engagements, and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid all tattling, backbiting, and excessive anger; to abstain from the sale and the use of intoxicating drinks as a beverage, and to be zealous in our effort to advance the kingdom of our Savior.

Minister: *Since One is our Master, even Christ and all we are brethren, by what fraternal ministries are we to strengthen each other and adorn the teachings of our Lord?*

Congregation: We further engage to watch over each other in brotherly love and watchfulness; giving and receiving admonition with meekness and affection; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rule of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

Minister: *For the good of our own Spiritual development, and for the best interest of the Master's kingdom, what do we promise to do if we move beyond the reach of this church?*

Congregation: We moreover engage that when we remove from this place, we will, as soon as possible, unite with some other church of this faith, where we can carry out the spirit of this Covenant and the principles of God's Word.

All: *Humbly confessing our past sins, we pray for grace and strength to keep these, our holy vows, for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen*
