Leader: *⁷Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong.*

Congregation: *⁸He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God.*

Leader: *⁹When all the people saw him walking and praising God,*
