WORSHIPPING WITH OUR CHILDREN

On Transfiguration Day we gather our "Alleluias", as represented in our children's Alleluia banners, into a grouping behind our wooden cross. This will help us remember that while we are quieting down our use of the word "Alleluia" during Lent, the Sundays throughout the year, including during Lent, are really little Easters. "Alleluia" is a Greek word that means "Praise the Lord". Our "Alleluias" are draped with a purple (the color of Lent) and black (the color of Good Friday) cloth. But we'll also know that He is risen indeed (look for the white of Easter) and that He is alive now and for all eternity! Take a moment after worship to visit the cross and gathered Alleluias.

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.


