## ARLEN MEYER BANNER DESCRIPTION

The final week of Lent is Passion week. The background color of the banner changes to blood red. Arlen has used the traditional palm branch as a symbol of praise and combines that symbol with a representation of stones. This connection is to remind us that God must be praised for what He is and does. He is worthy. When his disciples are criticized for too much praise, Jesus responds, "I tell you that if they keep quiet, the stones themselves will start shouting." Praise we must.

*Mark 11:1-11*

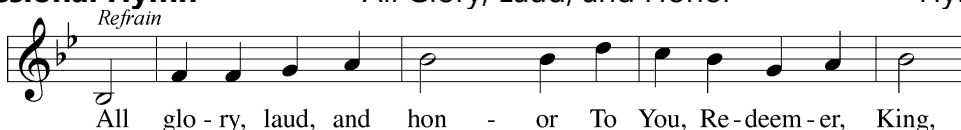




