






God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee...
















THIS SON...




But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship




The Angel went to her and said...

LUKE 1:38


"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled."
