

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



APPLICATION #1 JESUS DIDN'T COME TO BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY DEMONS. HE CAME TO BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY PEOPLE.

OBSERVE CHRIST'S TONE OF AUTHORITY AND STERNNESS. HE HAD PITY FOR MEN, WHO CAPABLE OF REDEMPTION, BUT HIS WORDS AND DEMEANOR TO THE DEMONIC SPIRITS ARE ALWAYS SEVERE. HE ACCEPTS THE MOST IMPERFECT RECOGNITION FROM MEN, ...BUT HE SILENCES THE EMONIC SPIRITS' CLEAR RECOGNITION IS 'UNTO SALVATION' COMES WHICH A HEART THAT LOVES, NOT MERELY FROM PERCEIVES; AND **JESUS ACCEPTS** WILL NOT HAVE HIS NAME NOTHING ELSE. "So he bent over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. She got up at once and began to wait on them."







- 1. Why does Jesus insist on going to other towns to preach, even when the people in Capernaum want Him to stay?
- 2. How do Jesus' actions in this chapter demonstrate His mission and purpose?
- 3. How does Jesus' rejection at Nazareth reflect on how we might be received when we share the gospel?
- 4. How does Jesus balance His time between healing, casting out demons, and preaching?
- 5. What does Jesus' retreat to a solitary place reveal about His spiritual practices, and how can we apply this to our lives?
- 6. How does the crowd's reaction to Jesus' message in Nazareth differ from their reaction in Capernaum, and what might this suggest about acceptance of the gospel message?
- 7. How does Jesus' interaction with the demonic realm in this chapter inform our understanding of His power and authority?
- 8. In the light of Jesus' healing miracles, how can we understand and approach illness and healing in a contemporary context?
