
Four states

Romans 6:8-10

"The Christian life is not just identifying with His death and dying to sins, but it is also rising into newness of life with Christ. True Christianity is living out a new, joyful, abundant resurrected life with Christ now! Today! Not just in the future."

...count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. (Romans 6:11 – the first imperative command in the book of Romans)

Believe it. Get your mind wrapped around it. Think it through. Consider yourself dead to sin. Reckon yourself fully powerfully alive in Christ.

And now live in this truth...

Romans 6:12-14 (more commands coming)

Your Mind



Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind... (Romans 12:2)

Growth Tip: For every hour of secular music/tv/book/social media you allow into your mind, add an hour of something that set's you mind on God. (Read the Bible, a great book, prayer, fellowship).

Growth Tip: Listen to worship, watch an uplifting movie.



The Tongue

The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell. (James 3:6)

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. (Ephesians 4:29)

Growth tip: Encourage, Speak Truth, Share Jesus!

Hands and Feet
