## January 1, 2023 Nehemiah 11-12:26: Grow in Community



Who Nehemiah? Where did he come from? What did he come to do?

Now the city was large and spacious, but there were few people in it, and the houses had not yet been rebuilt. (Nehemiah 7:4)

To build a community, they needed...

- people together,
- everyone using their gifts,
- to center the community around God and His Word.

How did they pick who would move into Jerusalem? From the descendants of Judah... (v. 4) From the descendants of Benjamin... (v. 7) From the priests... (v. 10) From the Levites... who had charge of the outside work... who led in thanksgiving and prayer (vs. 15-17) From the gatekeepers... who kept watch at the gates... (v. 19) The chief officers... (v. 22) The musicians... (v. 23) As for the villages with their fields, some of the people of Judah... they were living all the way from Beersheba to the valley of Hinnom (vs. 25-30)

The descendants of Benjamin from Geba... (vs. 31-36)

To build a community, we need...

- people together (offer our lives to God/God's people)
- everyone using their gifts (how can I serve God/my brothers and sisters?)
- to center the community around God and His Word

To build a community, we need people together.

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. (Romans 12:1)
