
How could you get different fruits to grow on the same tree?

Review from last week

If some of the branches have been broken off, and you, though a wild olive shoot, have been grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing sap from the olive root, do not consider yourself to be superior to those other branches. (Romans 11:17-18)

Review from last week

...they were broken off because of unbelief, and you stand by faith. Do not be arrogant, but tremble. (Romans 11:20)

Verses (25-27)

Don't consider yourself superior...do not be arrogant...so that you may not be conceited... (Romans 11)


Enemies?

In Thessalonica: "Some of the Jews were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, as did a large number of God-fearing Greeks and quite a few prominent women. But other Jews were jealous; so they rounded up some bad characters from the marketplace, formed a mob and started a riot in the city...." (Acts 17:4–5, NIV)

In Berea: "But when the Jews in Thessalonica learned that Paul was preaching the word of God at Berea, some of them went there too, agitating the crowds and stirring them up." (Acts 17:13, NIV)

In Corinth: "While Gallio was proconsul of Achaia, the Jews of Corinth made a united attack on Paul and brought him to the place of judgment. "This man," they charged, "is persuading the people to worship God in ways contrary to the law."" (Acts 18:12–13, NIV) Two things I want to say about these verses...

- 1. Paul says in regards to the Gospel of Jesus Christ, yeah, the Jews have been enemies of the spread of the gospel everywhere.
- 2. Luke writes that this happened while Gallio was proconsul of Achaia that they dragged Paul to the place of judgment (the Greek word is the Bema seat). Archaeology Nerd Moment



So, what does this archaeology nerd moment show us? God's Word again is shown to be trustworthy.

What about my unfaithfulness?



"Unfaithfulness is one of the most outstanding sins of these evil days. In the business world, a man's word is, with rare exceptions, no longer his bond. (Verses 33-36)
