Why is it called Good Friday?

Part 1: Read Luke 23:26-31

Part 2: Read Luke 23:32-43

What do you learn about the heart of God in these verses?

Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.
(Luke 23:34)

Truly I tell you, today you will be with Me in paradise.
(Luke 23:43)

One was saved upon the CROSS that none might despair; and only one, that none might presume. Now is the day of salvation.

Part 3: Read Luke 23:44-49

“Father into my hands I commit my spirit.”

No one takes My life from Me, but I lay it down of My own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again.
(John 10:18)

The Veil was torn...

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.

(Romans 5:1-2)

...to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

(Ephesians 2:16-18)

In Him and through faith in Him we may approach God with freedom and confidence. (Ephesians 3:12)
