I will give you and your descendants the land on which you are lying. 14 Your descendants will be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east, to the north and to the south. All peoples on earth will be blessed through you and your offspring. 15 I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you."

16 When Jacob awoke from his sleep, he thought, "Surely the Lord is in this place, and I was not aware of it." 17 He was afraid and said, "How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God; this is the gate of heaven."

- God showed up Unexpectedly...

Jacobs Encounter with God Revealed - Jacob was Special to God...

- Jacob found Favor in God's sight...
- Jacob found favor with God for many reasons...
- One being because of his lineage... He literally was special to God and didn't know it.
- · He was of Abraham and Isaac...
- His Fathers honored God and were men of Faith...
- There was a Spiritual Legacy passed down and he inherited something special...
- How Much Prayer and Obedience was sown before him that lead to that moment...
- Many of us have found ourselves in a place with God not because we deserved it, but because someone went before us and paid the price in Prayer and Obedience...
- We all Stand on the shoulders of someone. It could be a praying Grandmother, Mother, Father, Grandfather, Aunt, Uncle, Husband, Wife, Cousin, Friend, Pastor or Minister...
