A Church for the Hurting Part 4

2 Corinthians 5

13 If we are "out of our mind," as some say, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. **14** For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. **15** And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

16 So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. **17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! **18** All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: **19** that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. **20** We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us.

- Paul speaks often of his critics and their criticism of him in 2 Corinthians.
- He was criticized in his Doctrine and was seen as unimpressive in speech and in appearance by those who wanted to take his place of influence.

Vs. 13

<mark>Vs. 14,15</mark>

For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all... those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

For a Church to be used by God to reach a Hurting World they must be compelled by Christ's love.

Compelled: to force or oblige someone to do something.

Paul says Christ's love compels us... Compelled to tell people about Jesus...

Story: I love getting phone calls and hearing about how God is using so many of you to be a witness to others.

- People need to hear about Jesus from normal people...
- People who aren't "Ministers" and haven't gone to seminary...
- The Church becomes a powerful tool for the Kingdom when you and I feel compelled by the Love of God to tell others about the Him.

<mark>Vs. 17</mark> NKJV

Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Epiphany: The manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles. A moment of sudden revelation or insight.

"For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." **1 Cor. 1:18**

People really do need the Lord They may not even realize it yet Pray that they would Pray they would be brought to Need Him, Desire Him, Seek for Him Pray they would find Him Pray they would have an Epiphany

Anyone can be saved...

God saves the hardest of hearts...

God saves the wildest of sinners, in the darkest of places...

He makes them new...

A person who was once wild in the world, can become wild for Jesus...

Vs. 18

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:

Reconciliation:

1. **Exchange**; money changers, of the business of exchanging equivalent values,.

2. Restoration; of divine favor.

When I went to Israel, one of the first things we did was go to a Currency Exchange Booth. Because my American Money hand to be changed over to Israeli Money.

Luke 8 - The man called Legion

From tormented every day, driven to a solitary place, naked and unruly to sitting at Jesus' feet, dressed and in his right mind and sent back to his hometown to be a witness for Jesus.

Jesus is the Change Maker

Part 3

Acts 16 - <u>A certain slave girl with a spirit of divination (python)</u> There was an Exchange from the choke hold of the devil to free... Jesus is Making Change - He is the Change Maker

How about: Luke 15 - The Prodigal Son From a pig pen to the fathers house from stained, smelly garments to the fathers clean rob from lost identity to a fathers ring from hungry to the fattened calf

Are you seeing this? That's Reconciliation...

How about: Matthew 11

28 "Come to me, all you who are **weary and heavy laden** (burdened), and **I** will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for **I am** gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

• Jesus goes after the Hurting to make an Exchange...

From Weary, Burdened, Heavy to Rested, Gentle Humble and Light

Beauty <u>for</u> Ashes, The oil of Joy <u>for</u> Mourning, The Garment of Praise <u>for</u> the Spirit of Heaviness; From Weary <u>to</u> Rested From Yoked <u>to</u> Free From Heavy <u>to</u> Light
