James 1

2 Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, **3** because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. **4** Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

The Apostle James says, **Vs. 3** "the testing of your faith produces perseverance."

The ability to remain under it... Remain under the weight of it...

What Challenges you will Change you...

What is this Wisdom?

Wisdom: Wisdom that is broad and full of intelligence;

- The knowledge of very diverse matters.
- knowledge of things human and divine.
- the act of interpreting dreams and always giving the sagest advice
- skill in the management of affairs
- knowledge for godly and upright living
- supreme intelligence, such as belongs to God

Root Word: skilled expert. Forming the best plans and using the best means for their execution.

The Wisdom of God will change your perspective... The Wisdom of God will change your position...

Many times the difference between right thinking and wrong thinking is perspective...

Adam and Eve had no sin nature... How does Satan get someone who has no sin nature to sin? He altered their perspective...

- Did God really say... (False Truth)
- You will not surely die... (False Assurance)
- For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God... (False Hope)

When Jesus was tempted in the wilderness, Satan had a perspective, Jesus maintained the right perspective and the right position...

The Wisdom of God will take you further, faster...

What David dreamed of Solomon saw at a young age...

- Solomon was the only person God ever came to and said what is it that you want? I will give it to you...
- And Solomon was the only one who was ever taught how to answer the question...

Proverbs 4

For I too was a son to my father,

still tender, and cherished by my mother.

The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom.

Christianity is called the Faith; not the Reasoning.

Doubt: Uncertain or lack of Conviction

The one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blow and tossed by the wind...

Have you ever met that person? Have you ever been that person? Charles Spurgeon "We notice that not only must one come in **faith**, but one must also **ask in faith.**"

The person who doubts is like a wave, now *rising* by *hope*, then *sinking* by *despair*.

What we know about waves:

- A wave of the sea is without rest, and so is the doubter
- A wave of the sea is unstable, and so is the doubter
- A wave of the sea is driven by the winds, and so is the doubter
- A wave of the sea is capable of great destruction, and so is the doubter

That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do.

double-minded is literally *two-souled*. "The man of two souls, who has one for the earth, and another for heaven.

It's like the word division which means di-vision. Two visions... "A House divided against itself cannot stand."

But when you ask, you must believe...

Believe: Convinced, Persuaded

Faith has with it the: "Oh make up your mind" Anointing...

A Man of Conviction

During the American Revolution, Patriot General George Washington crosses the Delaware River with 5,400 troops, hoping to surprise British forces celebrating Christmas at their winter quarters in Trenton, New Jersey. The unconventional attack came after several months of substantial defeats for Washington's army that had resulted in the loss of New York City and other strategic points in the region.

At about 11 p.m. on Christmas, Washington's army commenced its crossing of the half-frozen river at three locations. The 2,400 soldiers led by Washington successfully braved the icy and freezing river and reached the New Jersey side of the Delaware just before dawn. The other two divisions, made up of some 3,000 men and crucial artillery, failed to reach the meeting point at the appointed time.

At approximately 8 a.m. on the morning of December 26, Washington's remaining force, separated into two columns, reached the outskirts of Trenton and descended on the unsuspecting Hessians (*German soldiers who served as auxiliaries to the British Army during the American Revolutionary War*).

Trenton's 1,400 Hessian defenders were groggy from the previous evening's festivities and underestimated the Patriot threat after months of decisive British victories throughout New York. Washington's men quickly overwhelmed the Germans' defenses, and by 9:30 a.m. the town was surrounded. Although several hundred Hessian Soldiers escaped, nearly 1,000 were captured at the cost of only four American lives.

This strategic move on General George Washington's part was the turning point of the Revolutionary War as news of Washington's initiative raised the spirits of the American colonists, who previously feared that the Continental Army was incapable of victory.
