1 Chronicles 14

8 When the Philistines heard that David had been anointed king over all Israel, they went up in full force to search for him, but David heard about it and went out to meet them. 9 Now the Philistines had come and raided the Valley of Rephaim; 10 so David inquired of God: "Shall I go and attack the Philistines? Will you deliver them into my hands?" The Lord answered him, "Go, I will deliver them into your hands." 11 So David and his men went up to Baal Perazim, and there he defeated them. He said, "*As waters break out, God has broken out against my enemies by my hand.*" So that place was called Baal Perazim.

12 The Philistines had abandoned their gods there, and David gave orders to burn them in the fire.

13 Once more the Philistines raided the valley; **14** so David inquired of God again, and God answered him, “Do not go directly after them, but circle around them and attack them in front of the poplar trees. **15** As soon as you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the poplar trees, move out to battle, because that will mean God has gone out in front of you to strike the Philistine army.” **16** So David did as God commanded him, and they struck down the Philistine army, all the way from Gibeon to Gezer.

17 So David’s fame spread throughout every land, and the Lord made all the nations fear him.

Vs. 10,11

10 so David inquired of God: “Shall I go and attack the Philistines? Will you deliver them into my hands?”

The Lord answered him, “Go, I will deliver them into your hands.”

11 So David and his men went up to Baal Perazim, and there he defeated them. He said, “As waters break out, God has broken out against my enemies by my hand.”

- David called the place Baal Perazim - *the lord who breaks out*
- David as the King and in regard to the nation of Israel did the right thing;
- He inquired of the Lord...
- David brought the situation before the Lord in prayer...

Vs. 13-16

13 Once more the Philistines raided the valley; **14** so David inquired of God again, and God answered him, “Do not go directly after them, but circle around them and attack them in front of the poplar trees. **15** As soon as you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the poplar trees, move out to battle, because that will mean **God has gone out in front of you to strike the Philistine army.**” **16** So David did as God commanded him, and they struck down the Philistine army

- God had a place in this battle...

“If God be for us, who can be against us.”

- David was a man after God’s Heart
- David was Righteous man and desired to follow God.

- The Philistines hated David and the God of David...
- So God showed up to the Battle...
- This time God gave David specific instruction...
- There was a strategy:
 - Wait for the Lord
 - Listen
 - When you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the poplar trees, move out to battle, because God has gone out in front of you...
- That means the angelic host of heaven
- The Waring Angles of heaven, came down, marching across the tops of the poplar trees and lead the battle against the Philistines...

David felt the Rumblings of God that day...

Moses said these words after God delivered the Israelites through the Red Sea

Exodus 14

29 But the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left.

Exodus 15

Who among the gods

Who is like you—

majestic in holiness,

Joshua 5

13 Now when Joshua was near Jericho, he looked up and saw a man standing in front of him with a drawn sword in his hand. Joshua went up to him and asked, “**Are you for us or for our enemies?**”

14 “**Neither,**” he replied, “but as commander of the army of the Lord I have now come.” Then Joshua fell facedown to the ground in reverence, and asked him, “What message does my Lord have for his servant?”

15 The commander of the Lord’s army replied, “Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy.” And Joshua did so.

Joshua went up to him and asked, “**Are you for us or for our enemies?**”

14 “**Neither,**” he replied,

Joshua 6

Now the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in.

2 Then the Lord said to Joshua, “**See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men.**

- Before it was God declares it is...

Romans 4:17 KJ21

...God, who quickeneth the dead and calleth those things which are not, as though they were.

- I love this about the Lord

The Lord Instruction:

3 March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days.

4 Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. **5** When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in.”

8 When Joshua had spoken to the people, the seven priests carrying the seven trumpets before the Lord went forward, blowing their trumpets, and the ark of the Lord's covenant followed them. **9** **The armed guard marched ahead of the priests who blew the trumpets, and the rear guard followed the ark.** All this time the trumpets were sounding.

Joshua in the process of doing what God told him to do:

1st He had to guard Worship

2nd He had to guard the Presence

If we want to see victory in our lives 1st guard your worship to God...

2nd guard the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life...

15 On the seventh day, they got up at daybreak and marched around the city seven times in the same manner, except that on that day they circled the city seven times. **16** The seventh time around, when the priests sounded the trumpet blast, Joshua commanded the army, “Shout! For the Lord has given you the city!”

20 When the trumpets sounded, the army shouted, and at the sound of the trumpet, when the men gave a loud shout, the wall collapsed; so everyone charged straight in, and they took the city.
