Children's Camp: \$100.00 is due March 12th.

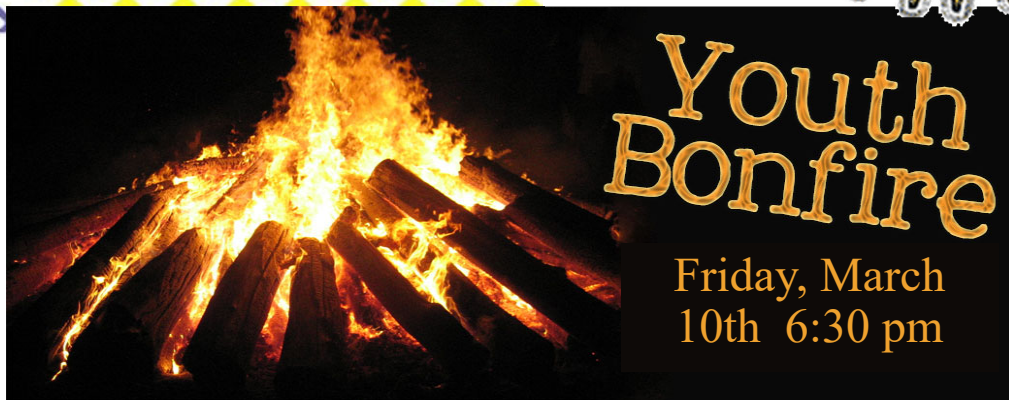
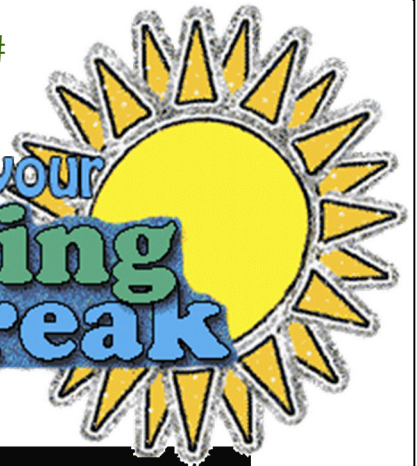
Memphis Mission Trip: \$145.00 or balance is due March 19th.
